Nominations

Each year, WJHSD alumni, staff members or volunteers from Thomas Jefferson High School can be nominated for entry into the Halls of Fame. Below are guidelines for nominations.

The annual deadline for nominations is **September 21**.

Criteria for Administration/Staff Inductees

A staff member or volunteer must meet the following criteria to be considered for the three halls of fame. The individual must no longer be employed by Thomas Jefferson High School. The individual must have made a significant and positive contribution during his/her association with Thomas Jefferson High School.

Staff members or volunteers will be nominated by members of the high school staff, the West Jefferson Hills alumni, or the West Jefferson Hills community. The nominees must earn a 75% vote of a quorum of the committee.

The individual's association with TJHS could have been as one or more of the following: Administrator, Teacher, Activity Advisor, Coach, Support Staff Member, School Board Member.

During his/her association with TJHS, the individual could have contributed in one or more of the following ways:

- Gave Outstanding Service in His/Her Position
- Made Impact on Students' Lives
- Made Innovative Contributions
- Initiated New Programs
- Provided Leadership in the Development of Facilities, Curriculum, Programs, etc.
- Earned Local, State, and/or National Recognition
- Represented TJHS in Local and/or National Educational Groups
- Published Work

Each Hall of Fame Committee will include representatives of the high school staff, of alumni, and of the community. The nominees must earn a 75% vote of a quorum of the committee.
