Thank you for participating in the Reflections Program! We ask that your child submit no more than two entries per category. An entry form must be submitted for each entry along with an electronic copy / jpg image of the artwork. **All entries are due back to school by Tuesday, March 6.**

GUIDELINES

- All work should be the **original work of the student.**
- **No names on the front** of entry and **do not identify/show student in a recording.**
- Remember to **attach the entry form.** For visual arts and photography, it should be *taped* on the back with the student's name folded under. For literature, staple to back folder with name folded under. For music, secure to envelope with name folded under.
Submit an electronic copy: Send an e-mail with an attachment of an electronic image/jpg photo of your child's artwork and send to gillhalleempta@yahoo.com. Be sure to include your child's name/title of artwork in the body of the e-mail. This is in addition to your physical submission and may be used for display at the assembly.

RULES BY CATEGORY

LITERATURE:

- Fiction and non-fiction including: prose, poetry, drama (play script), reflective essay, narrative, and short story
- Entry must not exceed 2,000 words
- 2 copies placed inside a manila folder
- Student's name written on the back of each page and each page numbered
- Handwritten or typed on one side only of 8 ½ x 11 paper
- Illustrated entries are accepted but not required

- Accepted files include: MP3, MP4, WMA, WAV, ACC and FLAC formats

PHOTOGRAPHY:

- Single photo, panoramic, photomontage (one seamless print of multiple images)
- Original black-and-white or color images
- Not to exceed 11 x14 inches (including mat)
- Mounted on cardboard mat, poster board, or other sturdy material (no frames)

MUSIC COMPOSITION:

- Original composition featuring any instrument, voice, or combination
- CD or flash drive in a container/envelope
- Copyright material is prohibited
- Less than 5 minutes in length
- Must include score (age appropriate)
- Composer may be the performer but is not required to be the performer

VISUAL ARTS:

- Acceptable forms: drawings, sketches, paintings, architecture (2D/3D), carpentry, ceramics, collages, photographic collages (multiple images cut/pasted), computer generated image, and crafts
- Paper entries must be mounted on sturdy material
- Any 2D/3D works must include a box with packaging materials and photo of the entry
