

Dr. Terrence Kushner was hired as Substitute Superintendent for the West Jefferson Hills School District, effective October 1, 2009, at a Special Board Meeting held today, October 6, 2009. Dr. Kushner previously served as the Assistant Superintendent of the Upper St. Clair School District since 2004. In his role there, he coordinated curriculum and instruction for Grades K-12 and managed the district's Communications Program. He began with Upper St. Clair in 1986 as a high school associate principal and then moved to high school principal in 1995.

Dr. Kushner is also an adjunct professor at Duquesne University where he teaches courses in secondary school administration and management. His extensive educational background includes previous roles in teaching, administration and coaching at Moon Area High School, Peters Township High School, Trinity High School and Baldwin High School.

Dr. Kushner holds degrees from Colgate University in New York where he received his Bachelor's Degree in Mathematics, a Ph.D. in Curriculum and Supervision from the University of Pittsburgh, Secondary Principal's certification from California University, and his Superintendent's Letter of Eligibility from West Virginia University.
