The Business and Personal Finance course provides students with a foundation for becoming educated consumers and successfully maintaining their own financial lives. Practical application is made to simulate lifelike situations and on-the-job experiences. Students will be exposed to personal matters such as cash control systems, credit, lending, insurance, taxes, and investments. Marketing, sales, purchasing, distribution, bookkeeping, and corporate financial management will also be introduced. This course is perfect for any 11th or 12th grade student looking to understand and control his or her own financial destiny.

During this course the student will:

1. Understand terminology related to personal and business financial applications.
2. Apply basic math skills to the solution of both personal and business applications.
3. Use formulas to solve a variety of personal and business mathematical problems.
