## Would a \$20,000 scholarship change your student's life this year?

The KFC® Colonel's Scholars Program could mean up to \$5,000 per year for tuition, fees, books, and room and board to your student.

The KFC® Colonel's Scholars Program was created in 2006 and is dedicated to assisting students with financial need who plan to pursue a bachelor's degree at a public institution within their legal state of residence. To qualify, a student must be:

- Graduating from high school this academic year (between 12/1/11 and 8/31/12)
- Maintaining a minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
- Enrolling in a public, in-state college or university (start date no later than 9/30/12)
- Demonstrate financial need
- A U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Plan to pursue a bachelor's degree

Scholars may begin their college career by entering into either a 2-or 4-year accredited in-state college/university, as long as they stay on track to complete a bachelor's degree program.

Students complete their application online at [www.kfcscholars.org](http://www.kfcscholars.org). The online application will be available from **December 1, 2011 through February 8, 2012**. Students will be asked to provide pertinent information about themselves and their family life, their activity level during high school, and compose a few short answer responses to various questions. The online application will allow the student to save their work as they go. Once the application period closes (February 8), a preliminary review of all applications submitted will take place (early March). Based on the preliminary review, students selected as semifinalists will then be asked to provide additional documents.

### *What should student be doing to prepare?*

Right now is the time for all students to complete a FAFSA ([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)). An estimate of financial need can also be calculated at [www.act.org/fane](http://www.act.org/fane).
