

PSECU SCHOLARSHIPS

Graduating high school students will once again have the opportunity to receive scholarship funds from PSECU. To qualify for one of six \$6,000 PSECU Scholarships, the student must be a PSECU member by Wednesday, February 29, 2012.

Students interested in joining PSECU must be eligible for membership. As you can see by the following list, there are many, many ways for them to qualify. The list includes state agencies, businesses, organizations and schools that all provide membership eligibility. A complete list is available at psecu.com/eligibility. Students who qualify may call or apply online at psecu.com/scholarships or check out the scholarship binder for the application.

IMPORTANT!

Students who are PSECU members must contact us for a scholarship application by calling 800.237.7328 nationwide or 717.234.8484 in the Harrisburg area. The application has a section the student fills out and an Academic Profile that the Guidance Counselor must fill out. Students must complete their section before giving the packet to the guidance counselor.

After the packet is completed, you must mail the packet to PSECU. All applications must be received by noon on Wednesday, February 29, 2012. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Please use the prepaid envelope that is sent with the scholarship application or mail to PSECU SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, P.O.
