STREAM OF LEARNING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM-2012

Pennsylvania American Water's *Stream of Learning Scholarship Program* was created to provide post-secondary scholarship assistance to students living in Pennsylvania American Water's service areas who plan a course of study critical to the water and waste-water industry. To apply for a \$2,000 scholarship, students must:

1. Currently live in one of Pennsylvania American Water's service areas. (Students may be planning on attending college outside of our service areas.) A copy of the applicant's household water bill should be included for verification.

PLEASE NOTE: Family members of Pennsylvania American Water employees are not eligible.

2. Plan to attend a two or four year college or technical school.
3. Plan to study environmental science, environmental engineering, biology or chemistry.
4. Complete an application.
5. Write a short essay about their career interests.
6. Include a letter or recommendation from a teacher or community service leader, please include phone numbers.
7. Include an official high school transcript. Submit completed application, Essay, copy of household water bill and letter/letters of recommendation to guidance office and transcript will be mailed with the above.
