The Walmart Associate Scholarship is a college scholarship that is available associates in any division of Walmart and Sam's Club. Associates must be based in the U.S. and should demonstrate financial need and involvement in their community.



The Walmart Associate Scholarship is available for associates seeking certificates, associates, bachelors, and graduate degrees through accredited institutions of higher education and for associates participating in the Lifelong Learning Program through American Public University. The Foundation accepts applications and awards Walmart Associate Scholarships four times a year, as shown in the chart below.

***Note: You must have been employed at least 6 months prior to the Scholarship Launch Date below**

[The Walmart Dependent Scholarship](#)

Application Period Opens January 3, 2012 and ends March 15, 2012.

The Walmart Dependent Scholarship is a \$13,000 scholarship paid out over four years. Applicants must be dependents of Walmart or Sam's Club associates in any U.S. division, have at least a 2.0 high school GPA and prove financial need.
