









Creating a Parent Observer Account in Canvas

- This page explains how to link your student's Canvas account to the **Canvas Parent Observer Account**.
- Your student will be using Canvas this year as part of our online learning delivery system. As a parent, we highly encourage you to create a Parent Observer account to follow along with your student's coursework, assignment due dates, and grades. **It is recommended that you create your parent account with your student alongside you.**

Directions:

1	<p>Once your child is logged into their Canvas account on their chromebook:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on 'Account'  button located on the left side of the global navigation.2. Click on 'Settings' and click on the  button on the right side of the screen.3. Write down the pairing code. You will use this pairing code to link to your child's account.
2	<p>How to set up your Canvas Parent Account:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Logout of your child's account- Click on  and then .2. In the browser address, type wjhsd.instructure.com3. Click on 'Need a Canvas Account? Click Here, It's Free!'  <ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Next, click on 'Parents Sign Up Here'  <ol style="list-style-type: none">5. Complete the 'Parent Sign Up' details including adding the student pairing code that you wrote down in section 1 above. Click on 'Start Participating' <p>***You can add additional students to your parent account by generating an Observer Pairing Code from the other student's account. More info can be found at https://bit.ly/3g3cceu</p>
<p>NOTE: There is a Canvas Parent App for iOS and Android. You can use both the Canvas Parent App and the web to access your parent observer account. Your username and password will be the same.</p>
