One personal decision you would want to make first is what version of Quizzes you want to use.


There are two versions of the Quiz creator in Canvas: New vs Classic Quizzes Our district is allowing each teacher to choose between what version to use.

What's the Difference?

- Classic Quizzes is the original quiz tool in Canvas.
- New Quizzes is a new quiz tool still in development by Canvas. It was released late summer 2020 and features are still being added.


Eventually, New Quizzes will replace Classic Quizzes, but not all at once. Canvas is still soliciting feedback for New Quizzes. You can share your thoughts at: https://community.canvaslms.com/groups/quizzes

Here's what it looks like when you are prompted to select:



If you are not automatically prompted to choose a Quiz engine, you can turn the new quizzes version on or off in the following area:

1. Go to **Settings/ Feature Options**, you will see a place to enable New Quizzes by clicking on the slide button. It will turn from black to green. For some reason, you are being prompted to turn it on in your course now.
