PHMS Instructions for the Week of August 31- September 4

Thank you to our students and parents for their cooperation and patience during the first week of school. We hope you had a chance to meet your teachers and learn a little bit about your classes. All students should have completed the Canvas modules related to Health and Safety, Common Sense Media, Canvas Tutorial, and the Dignity and Respect Program. For this week, we begin in-person and Canvas learning for students. Below we provide daily instructions of what to know for each day of the week. We thought this would be helpful as we begin our transition to the hybrid model and Canvas online learning model. Can't wait to see all the students next week!

Monday, 8/31 Hybrid Students In-Person

• Dignity Group students (last names A-L) are in-person today.

- Remember to bring the following: Chromebook (fully charged), water bottle, face covering, a bagged lunch if you're not buying one in the cafeteria, a book to read (required for any study hall, 30 minutes of reading) and a backpack/drawstring bag.
 - Students will not be using lockers until further notice, hence the need for a bookbag or drawstring bag.
- Arrival- Bus students will arrive between 7:30 and 7:45 AM. Car riders and walkers will arrive between 7:40 AM and 7:50 AM. Car riders will be dropped off on Dutch Lane or in the Prince of Peace Church Parking Lot at the top of the middle school driveway. There are crossing guards in both locations. All students should be in homeroom by 7:55 AM.
- All students will follow the block schedule for their grade level listed below. It's a "B" Day schedule (this only applies to students' physical education, general music, and study hall).
- For homeroom, staff will direct you to your room assignment when you enter the main lobby. You will then report to Period 1, Period 4, Period 3, and Period 2 in that order.
- For lunch, grade level lunch times are listed on the colored schedules. We will use the PA system to call students to the cafeteria by homeroom. Students will take your bookbag/drawstring bag with you to lunch. You will be directed to a seat in the cafeteria, LGI room, or library. We will follow social distancing regulations.
- Dismissal- Bus students will be dismissed at 1:10 PM. 6th grade bus students will be dismissed first for the entire week. 7th and 8th grade bus students will follow. All car riders and walkers will be dismissed between 1:15 and 1:20 PM. You can pick your child up on Dutch Lane or the Prince of Peace Church Parking lot. (Please be patient while waiting for your child. The first couple days tend to go a little slower for dismissal and for buses to arrive at all bus stops).

Canvas Students/Hybrid Students Online

- *Respect Group students (last names M-Z) are participating online. Canvas students (5 days a week)* and Hybrid Online students will follow the block schedule for their grade level listed below. It's a "B" Day schedule (this only applies to students' physical education, general music, and study hall).
- *Homeroom* Online students WILL NOT report for homeroom. Make sure you are prepared for period 1 at 8 AM.

- For the first days of school, please give your teachers additional time to start the lesson while they help the in-person students get to their assigned seats and situated.
- You will need to log-in to Canvas. Please click on the Canvas link. If you need instructions, click the link <u>Canvas Log-in</u> <u>Instructions Link.</u>
- If you have a study hall during any class period, you WILL NOT report but you are required to complete 30 minutes of reading during that time. There are not any study hall courses in Canvas.
- *Period 1* Students will log into Canvas and locate their Period 1 course on their dashboard. Find the meeting link posted in Canvas.
- *Period 4* Students WILL NOT log into Canvas for this class period for the first week. Dr. McCauley and Mr. Como will share information with students about the new school year through a livestream video. The students will receive a link to the livestream video and a link to a Google Form in their Skyward/Email account. They will watch the video link and complete the Google Form.
- *Period 2 and Period 3* Students will log into Canvas, locate their course, and find the meeting link posted in Canvas.
- *Lunch Period* Students DO NOT report anywhere online for lunch. Students will eat lunch on your own and join back online for your next class at the appropriate time period.
