





Creating a Parent Account in Canvas

- This page provides information about how to link your child's Canvas account to the Canvas Parent App.
- Your student will be using Canvas this year as part of our online learning delivery system. As a parent, we highly encourage you to create a Parent Observer account to follow along with your student's coursework, assignment due dates, and grades. **It is recommended that you create your parent account with your student alongside you.**

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Once your child is logged into their Canvas account:

1. Click on 'Account'  button located on the left side of the global navigation.
2. Click on 'Settings' and click on the  button on the right side of the screen.
3. **Write down the pairing code.** You will use this pairing code to link to your child's account in a Canvas parent App.
4. If your child would like to use the Canvas **Student** app, stay in the account tab and click on 'QR for Mobile Login.' The QR code will appear on the screen. Once the Canvas **Student** App is downloaded, scan the QR code from the screen to login to the student's account.

How to set up your Canvas Parent Account:

1. Download the Canvas Parent App from your App store.
2. Open the app and click on 'Find School.'
3. Type in **wjhsd** and click '**WJHSD-Parents**'
4. If you do not already have a Canvas account, click on the link below 'Parent of a Canvas User'?
5. Complete the 'Parent SignUp' details including adding the **student pairing code** that you wrote down in section 3 above. Click on '**Start Participating**'
