PUPIL REGULATIONS AFFECTING BUS STUDENTS

1. Students must obey bus drivers promptly as they are in full charge of buses and pupils while in transit.
2. Students must be on time at the designated bus stops. Buses cannot wait.
3. Students must stay off the roadway at all times while waiting for buses.
4. Students must cross in front of the bus when crossing a highway.
5. Students must wait until the bus has come to a stop before attempting to enter or leave the bus.
6. Students must keep their arms and heads inside the bus at all times.
7. Students must remain seated at all times while the bus is in motion.
8. Any damage to the bus should be reported to the driver at once.
9. Any student causing a disturbance on the bus will be suspended from riding the bus.
10. Any student disfiguring or mutilating a bus will be held responsible.
11. No smoking will be permitted on the bus. Violation of this regulation will result in disciplinary action.
12. Students will be picked up and discharged only at designated stops.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE REGULATIONS WILL HAVE THEIR RIDING PRIVILEGES SUSPENDED BY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.
