WJHSD CYBER ACADEMY

- Students choosing the Cyber Academy will work at home and will not be required to attend synchronous sessions or in-person classes
- Teacher assistance will be provided on an as needed basis and may occur in person or virtually
- Students work at their own pace utilizing the Edgenuity online learning platform (5-12) or Edgenuity's Compass learning platform (K-4)
- Instruction is completely asynchronous, so students can log in at anytime to engage in learning
- The system is available in the evening and on weekends to accommodate students' schedules
- Students will learn similar skills as their classmates, but content and resources will differ
- Assignments, content, videos, and instructional resources are designed and created by Edgenuity instructors
- WJHSD teachers will monitor and support student learning by viewing assignments, providing feedback, and offering assistance upon request
