CANVAS

- Students may opt to learn from home 5 days per week
- Students log in to the Canvas Learning Management System to view assignments and interact with their classmates and teachers
- Instruction and coursework are both synchronous and asynchronous, so students may be expected to complete assignments during class time as well as independently
- Students will work on the same assignments and content as their classmates
- Content and assignments are planned, designed, and uploaded by WJHSD classroom teachers
- Teachers will support students in real time and will be available during office hours to offer support and assistance as well as to provide feedback
- Students will automatically be enrolled in Canvas along with their classmates

WJHSD CYBER ACADEMY

- Students choosing the Cyber Academy will work at home 5 days per week
- Students work at their own pace utilizing the Edgenuity online learning platform (5-12) or Edgenuity's Compass learning platform (K-4)
- Instruction is completely asynchronous, so students can log in at anytime to engage in learning
- Students will learn similar skills as their classmates, but content and resources will differ
- Assignments, content, videos, and instructional resources are designed and created by Edgenuity instructors
- WJHSD teachers will monitor and support student learning by viewing assignments, providing feedback, and offering assistance upon request
- Students and parents must complete the appropriate enrollment form located on the WJHSD Cyber Academy home page

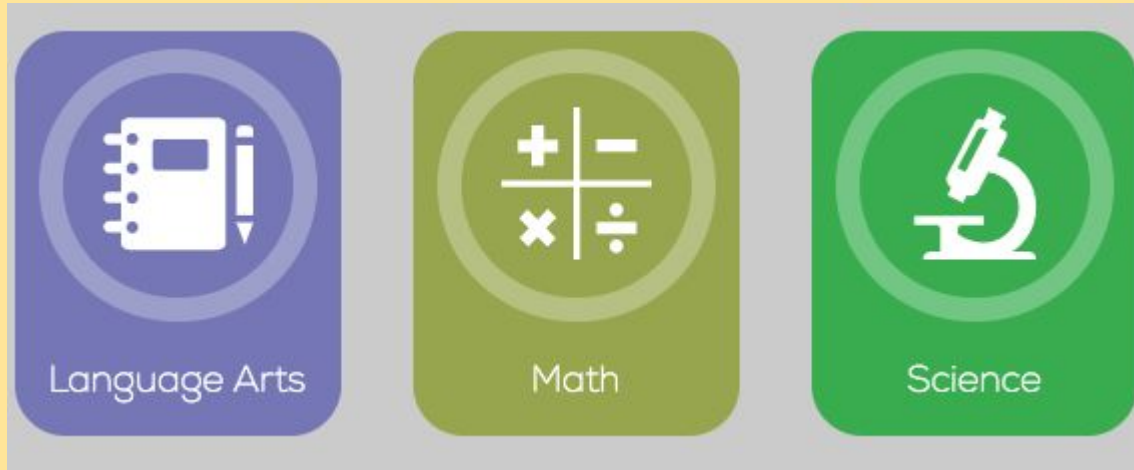

A typical course load for 4-5 is: ELA, Math, Social Studies, and Science.

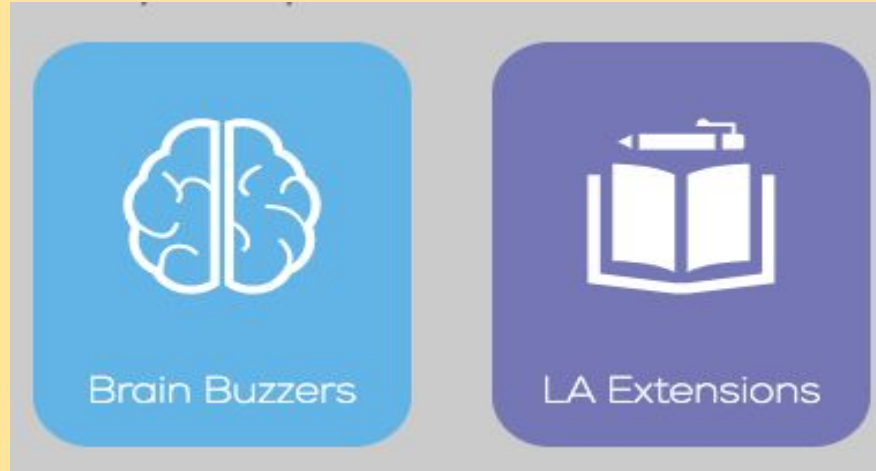
