## Understanding the Hybrid / Day A-J Schedule



## Students' Daily Instructional Schedule (At-Home and In-School)

Whether "In-School" or "At-Home", JHIS students are expected to follow the same daily schedule. Students should be logged into their devices and READY TO LEARN for all periods/classes (Homeroom, Reading, Spelling/Grammar, Writing, Math, Science, Social Studies, Encore) to the greatest extent possible. Portions of the lessons will be live and interactive with the respective teachers throughout the day. If you are unable to attend at those times, students will have access recordings and complete the required work *prior to* the next instructional day.
