Dear Students/Parents:

Summer School information is attached for your review. Please read all information carefully. **Anyone who is planning to attend summer school, regardless of the reason, is asked to consult with his or her counselor.** Any family that is having a difficult time financially and is worried about the cost of summer school should contact the appropriate counselor to discuss options as well.

There are a few options available for a student who has failed a course that is part of the graduation requirements at Thomas Jefferson High School. If a student has failed just one class and is still on track to graduate on time, re-taking the course next year at the high school is an option. The exception to this is English, which is required all four years of high school. **Students who have failed multiple required classes** most likely need to recover credits through one of the approved **Summer School Credit Recovery programs in this packet.**

Only 3.0 credits can be earned over the summer regardless of the option selected.

Students must earn enough credits each year to stay on track with on-time graduation or they will be reclassified based on the number of earned credits. Students must have earned the listed number of credits or more to be in the corresponding grade level.

Credit Recovery for a Failed Class:

- Option 1: **Scheduling and re-taking the class the following year/semester at TJ.** Under this option, the grade and credit earned will be applied to the GPA during the year/semester the class was rescheduled and passed. The GPA earned the year or semester the class was failed will not change.
- Option 2: **Completing an approved summer school program.**
Passing a class using this option will not change the student's GPA at TJ. However, the course and grade will be listed on the student's transcript as Credit Recovery and the credit will be applied toward meeting graduation requirements. Approved programs are listed below and information is attached:
***Project Succeed** – classes are held at Keystone Oaks HS **in person** - \$150/credit
***IU 1 Fusion Cyber Solutions**- online through the IU1; \$125/credit
***Waterfront Learning** – Online - \$260/credit
***ignite Education Solutions(Learning Lamp)** – Online (\$160/credit, \$130/credit if student qualifies for free/reduced lunch)
***Keystone Credit Recovery** – Online (\$155/credit) or Correspondence (Paper-pencil format, \$116/credit)

PROJECT SUCCEED SUMMER SCHOOL 2021 SCHEDULE

Project Succeed will offer Summer School classes. The classes will run from Monday, June 21, 2021 through Friday, July 16, 2021. Students can choose to attend classes either, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon or 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

*Please note that there will be two sessions of Math that will be offered. They will also be scheduled from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon, and 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. At this time enrollment will be limited to twelve students for each session due to covid restrictions, and will be on a first come, first serve basis. ****If Covid restrictions are lifted enrollment will increase.***

Students must attend all sessions, complete all assigned work, and pass all exams in order to receive credit for the course (.50 credit is awarded). Students will also have the opportunity to do one-half credit of Independent Study in each academic area. Independent studies will be given to students at the first class meeting and must be completed and returned to the instructor by Thursday of the session that the students attends. It is the student's responsibility to complete all facets of the Independent Study as set forth by the instructor. Failure to do so will be result in no credit. Any missed classes will result in no credit.

For students in grades 6–12 who would like to advance academically by taking additional courses over the summer. The *approximate* time commitment is 15–20 hours per week for 10 weeks.

Recover Now!

For students in grades 6–12 who have already taken a course during the regular school year and need to improve their performance. Students have the opportunity to create a customized learning path through diagnostic testing. Students have four (4) weeks to complete the course and should commit *approximately* 10 hours per week. Recover Now! courses are **NOT NCAA** approved.

Explore

Explore courses allow students to learn more about a career or field before committing to the field at a post-secondary establishment. The *approximate* time commitment is 10 hours per week for 10 weeks.

Elementary & Middle School Summer Bridge Program

Online Credit Recovery

Description: High-speed internet and Microsoft Office or knowledge of Google Docs are required for all students who enroll in these courses. It is a good option for self-motivated students. All courses are taught by certified teachers and are ideal for those who need a flexible schedule. Online CR course catalog includes all core courses and electives for grades 6-12.

- Pricing: \$160 (Tuition assistance is available for those who qualify)
- Session 1: register by noon on June 3, 2021. Classes begin June 7 and end July 16 at noon
- Session 2: register by noon on June 24, 2021. Classes begin June 28 and end August 6 at noon
- Students are responsible for any additional materials required by the course (particularly in science courses that include kitchen labs)
