Dear Students/Parents:

Summer School information is attached for your review. Please read all the information carefully. Anyone who is planning to attend summer school, regardless of the reason, is asked to consult with his or her counselor. Any family that is having a difficult time financially and is worried about the cost of summer school should contact the appropriate counselor to discuss options as well.

There are a few options available for a student who has failed a course that is part of the graduation requirements at Thomas Jefferson High School. If a student has failed just one class and is still on track to graduate on time, re-taking the course next year at the high school is an option. The exception to this is English, which is required all four years of high school. **Students who have failed multiple required classes** most likely need to recover credits through one of the approved **Summer School Credit Recovery programs in this packet.**

Only 3.0 credits can be earned over the summer regardless of the option selected.

Students must earn enough credits each year to stay on track with on-time graduation or they will be reclassified based on the number of earned credits. Students must have earned the listed number of credits or more to be in the corresponding grade level.

Credit Recovery for a Failed Class:

Option 1: **Scheduling and re-taking the class the following year/semester at TJ.** Under this option, the grade and credit earned will be applied to the GPA during the year/semester the class was rescheduled and passed. The initial F will also stay on the transcript and will not be changed or removed.

Option 2: **Completing an approved summer school program.**

Passing a class using this option will not change the student's GPA at TJ. However, the course and grade will be listed on the student's transcript as Credit Recovery and the credit will be applied toward meeting graduation requirements. 2024 Summer School Information

Online Credit Recovery

Description: High-speed internet and Microsoft Office or knowledge of Google Docs are required for all students who enroll in these courses. It is a good option for self-motivated students. All courses are taught by certified teachers and are ideal for those who need a flexible schedule. Online CR course catalog includes all core courses and electives for grades 6-12.

- Pricing: \$165 (Tuition assistance is available for those who qualify)
- Session 1: register by noon on June 6, 2024. Classes begin June 10 and end July 19 at noon
 - Live help session on June 11 via Google Meet
- Session 2: register by noon on June 27, 2024. Classes begin July 1 and end August 9 at noon
 - Live help session on July 2 via Google Meet
 - *Online coursework will be accessible on July 4 but main office will be closed that day. Staff will not be available.
- Students are responsible for any additional materials required by the course (particularly in science courses that include kitchen labs)

Guided Summer School

Description: Students report to class for 15 hours of direct instruction time (on a flexible schedule) at Johnstown and Somerset locations. Outside of class, students work remotely to complete independent work.

- Pricing: \$200 (Tuition assistance is available for those who qualify)
- Locations: GJCTC (445 Schoolhouse Road, Johnstown) and Somerset Location (TBA)
- Johnstown Location: Classes start as early as Monday, June 10 and end Thursday, August 8
- Somerset Location: Classes start the week of July 1 and end Thursday, August 8
- Registration deadline: July 18, 2024 at noon.

Credit Recovery Tuition

Keystone's credit recovery program offers students an affordable way to get their education back on track. The tuition covers everything needed to successfully complete the credit recovery units and there are no hidden fees.

Online Tuition

Online credit recovery courses are broken into Part A and Part B, corresponding to the first and second semester of a full-year course, and each part consists of approximately 60 hours of coursework.

When a student takes only the first or second part of an online credit recovery course, tuition for that one-semester course is \$116. If a student needs to recover credits for a full-year course and takes both online parts in sequence, tuition for the combined two-semester/one year course is \$155 total.

No shipping and handling fees apply. All course materials are available online and assignments are submitted electronically*.

*Some English courses require the student to borrow or purchase novels themselves, at their own expense. Please refer to the <u>credit recovery course catalog</u> of any additional requirements.

Correspondence Tuition


Correspondence units include 30–45 hours of content per course. Each course is equivalent to a full year (two semesters) of that course. Tuition for each course is \$116.

Shipping and handling of course materials**.

2024 McKeesport Area School District Summer School

The McKeesport Area School District will be offering virtual (online) & in-person summer classes beginning Monday, July 8, through Thursday, July 25, 2024. Virtual class offerings are for students from other districts. All MASD students are required to attend in person only.

Registration will be held at McKeesport High School (front entrance) on July 1, 2, 3, from 9:00AM – 12:00PM. All registrations must be completed by these dates. Registrations will not be accepted without full payment.

Payment must be made in cash or money order only. No checks will be accepted. Payments not received by the first day of classes will result in immediate termination from the program. MASD students are responsible for \$100.00 of the \$140.00 for a full credit class. The district will subsidize the remaining \$40.00. Half credit classes are \$70.00, and the students will pay \$50.00 with the district subsidizing the remaining \$20.00.

Students from outside districts will pay full price of \$140.00 or \$70.00 as subsidy will only be applied for MASD students.

The MASD reserves the right to cap the amount of subsidy they are willing to provide so it is highly recommended that students register sooner than later if they need assistance.

REFUND POLICY: The only refunds that will be given will be for courses canceled by MASD. Refunds will not be given to students who drop out or are dismissed from the program for misconduct.

One credit courses: Tuition is \$140.00 per course.

The one (1) credit classes are held from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Monday – Thursday. Please note there will be no Friday classes per school district policy.

Half credit courses: Tuition is \$70.00 per course.

- 1. Physical Education (Number of sessions depends on enrollment)
- 2. Health
- 3. Writing Studio/Writing Studio II

Physical Education/Writing Studio/Health classes will be held from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Please note that we will only offer one three-week session of classes this year beginning on July 8 and ending on July 25. All classes will be conducted Mondays — Thursdays. Classes will be held at McKeesport High School.

MASD Summer School Rules and Regulations

REGISTRATION: No registration will be accepted without a signed permission slip from a guidance counselor. All registrations must be completed by the assigned dates and all fees must be paid in cash or by money order at the time of registration.

DRESS CODE: In accordance with MASD's dress code, hooded jackets are not permitted to be worn by students...no exceptions!!!

ATTENDANCE: Any student who misses more than one class will not receive credit for the course. Students must submit a valid excuse from their parent or guardian to their teacher for each absence. In the case of hospitalization, funeral or extended illness, the student must submit a physician's or funeral director's note to the teacher. Absence for other school-based activities will not count as a valid excuse. Once on campus students are not permitted to leave for any reason; leaving will result in termination from the program without a refund.

TARDINESS: Two acts of tardiness will be counted as one full day absence from class. Students who arrive more than 10 minutes after the class is scheduled to begin will be marked absent. These are counted as part of the above attendance requirements.

GRADES: Final grades will not be issued until the student's registration fees and other debts have been paid in full.

USE OF TOBACCO: Students are not permitted to use tobacco on school property. Students found using tobacco are subject to dismissal from summer school.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT: Any student who engages in fighting, threatening or violent behavior, makes unreasonable noise, uses obscene language, makes obscene gestures, or creates a hazardous condition is guilty of disorderly conduct, can be arrested and will be terminated from summer school.

VALUABLES: Students are not to bring valuables or an excess amount of money to school. The MASD will not be responsible for any valuables or money lost or stolen.

CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY: Students are responsible for the proper care of all books, supplies, and furniture supplied by the school. Students who disfigure property, break windows or damage school property or equipment will be required to pay for the damage before a final grade is submitted.

ELECTRONICS: Students should not bring electronics to school. If they do, the district takes no responsibility for the safety of such products.

CHEATING: Any student caught cheating will be automatically dismissed from summer school and will forfeit their payment.

WEAPONS: The MASD policy on weapons will apply for summer school as well. Weapons are defined as follows: knives, guns, cutting instruments, brass knuckles, mace/pepper spray, explosives, or any look-alike weapon. Any instrument that may cause bodily injury is included on the prohibited list. The weapons policy can be found on page 43 of the MASD Student Handbook Planner if additional clarification is needed.

Absenteeism Policy:

If a student is absent due to a scheduled court appearance this is part of the allotted one-day absence, this absence is not in addition to the one-day absence policy.

Do not schedule a doctor's or a dental appointment during planned school hours. If it is necessary to do so, this will count for the allotted one-day absence.

Hospitalization for scheduled surgery requiring more than the allotted one day is not considered valid and may result in being dismissed from summer school.

Students becoming ill while at school and who require an early dismissal will be counted as missing a full day.

SUGGESTION: Try not missing your first day too early in the session...an unexpected illness or emergency could happen later.

Money will not be refunded for dismissal from the program.

Any disruptive or destructive behavior on the last day will forfeit receipt of a grade and credit for the course.
